POLISH ADVENTURERS OUT IN AFRICA - IN A FIAT PANDA

Armed with just their wits and a little Fiat Panda Cross 4X4, intrepid Polish explorers Jolanta Czupik and Dominik Stoklosa are intent on covering 70 000 km around Africa in only six months. With Cape Town scheduled as a halfway stop the pair have covered 14 countries and clocked just under 32 000 km since departing from Poland on January 18. The twosome have travelled from their home country through Germany, France and Spain, across the Mediterranean Sea by ferry to Morocco, Mauritania, Mali, Niger, Nigeria, Cameroon, Gabon, Congo - Brazzaville, DRC, Angola and Namibia along the continent's West Coast. After the Mother City, they are making their way up to Botswana, and travel through Zimbabwe, Mozambique, Tanzania, Uganda, Sudan, Egypt, Jordan, Syria, Turkey, Russia and the Ukraine, before arriving back in Poland.
